This person will be involved with all aspects of the design process, and you will be comfortable working on a range of projects at any one time. This position is suitable for someone who is highly organised and comfortable multi-tasking in a fast-paced environment. Strong technical design knowledge and experience, from concept through to delivery is vital, as are strong presentation and communication skills. A background in architecture is advantageous.

The successful applicant will relish owning a crucial part of the growth journey of an exciting brand within a small team. This is a full-time role (Monday to Friday), based at our premises in Hammersmith, London.

Responsibilities:

- Assist and take direction from the Head of Design in scheming, sourcing, sampling and budgeting.
- Support the delivery of presentations to clients.
- Manage FF&E and interior architectural elements of the design through all the stages from conception through to installation, including procurement.
- Prepare and manage comprehensive schedules. (Lighting, Hard Finishes etc.)

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- Ability to produce technical drawings such as floor plans, elevations, joinery and bespoke furniture.
- Liaising with the clients, suppliers, contractors and consultants as needed.
- Working with our in-house Procurement Manager to build supplier relationships, develop samples and deliver projects in a timely manner.

Although these will be your main responsibilities, the nature of working in an exciting and growing practice means that you will be exposed to other aspects of the business, with a willingness to get involved essential.

Ideal Candidate:

- At least 4 years interior design experience in the high-end residential market. Architectural experience would be a bonus.
- Enthusiasm for interior design and working knowledge of the interiors industry.
- A team player with attention to detail and strong organisation skills.
- Adaptable to changing priorities and proven experience multi-tasking.
- High level of proficiency in AutoCad, Estimac, Photoshop and Microsoft Office. (We currently work with Rhino 2D, experience with this would be a plus but not essential).

 - Competent in taking meetings and site visits without line manager.
 - Self-motivated able to work independently and as part of a team.
 - Must be a detail orientated, problem solver with great negotiation skills and comfortable handling budgets.
 - Fluent in spoken and written English.
 - UK resident, ideally based in London – you will be required in person at our Hammersmith studio full time.
