We are looking for junior designer to join the team working on a series of projects, both residential and retail, at our studio in Hoxton.

The ideal candidate will be able to proactively contribute to the role below with creativity, professionalism, independence and great organisational skills. We are a happily small studio, so the role will involve working across all touchpoints of the business.

The role is to assist on projects with the possibility to take on more of a lead on the creative over time. A good steer on residential design is required, while knowledge and interest in commercial design is essential as an expanding part of the business.

We are looking for a candidate that will offer:

- Administrative support - costing projects, overseeing/tracking orders, arranging deliveries and installation, managing client feedback and meeting notes, diarising key dates of shopfits on the retail side, coordinating project photoshoots.
- Technical support - creating convincing renders and strong visual decks, floor plans, furniture set-outs, lighting plans and elevation drawings. Knowledge of Vectorworks, Photoshop/Illustrator is required; experience in SketchUp, Keynote and Programa is a plus.
- Design support - assisting on initial creative concepts, image research, sourcing FF&E, schemes, compiling client presentations, plus helping research on great brand benchmarks, suppliers (uniforms, packaging, craftspeople) on the retail side. It would be working under the creative director at first but there is plenty of opportunity to grow. Proactive input into the design (new suppliers, new materials, fresh new concepts) would be very welcome.

The position would be part-time with the idea of expanding after a set trial period. Salary will be based on experience.
